# **SERVICE CREW INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Notes to Service Crews**

Service Crews are advised that they should plan their trip to Benarkin to allow approximately 2 hours from Brisbane. As a sport, we gain the approval or special permissions from many Government Departments, Agencies and Councils and our actions are highly visible to the public and these organisations. Therefore we request that all Service Crews drive in a courteous and professional manner that will be a credit to our sport. We know that it damages us all if any crews drive on public roads in a way that emulates rally drivers.

As each car's odometer readings are different the distances shown on the route instructions later in this guide may differ from those shown by your vehicle. Therefore, you may need to take account of these differences when following the attached instructions.

If you wish to spectate on the Rally please use the official spectator instructions and **do not** try to access areas other than the designated spectator points.

If your competing crew are unable to continue during the event, every reasonable effort will be made to inform you of their location and what action needs to be safely taken, as is the case in all other rallies

## **How to get to Benarkin State School**

From Brisbane follow the Bruce Highway and take the Kilcoy turnoff (not the Caboolture exit). Follow this road through Wamuran and Woodford until you reach Kilcoy. In Kilcoy, take the D'Aguilar Highway (signposted Esk and Nanango) and follow past the Esk and Somerset Dam exits to Moore before climbing the Blackbutt Range. From Moore, follow the Highway for about 16.5 kms and take the first turnoff to Benarkin State School (Scott Street).

Please park and set up in the designated Service Area (see attached map). To enable all cars to be serviced here, please limit the area you use. Trailers can be parked on the opposite side of Scott Street.

## **Speed Limits within and around Benarkin, Blackbutt and Yarraman**

The Benarkin, Blackbutt and Yarraman communities are aware of having the Rally happening around their townships. Please respect their hospitality and goodwill by driving sensibly and always complying with local speed limits and those set out in the Service and Spectator instructions.

The area around Benarkin School will be active with rally traffic including officials, competing crews, service vehicles, spectator vehicles and local residents. In addition, young children could also be running, walking and playing in the area. Please be attentive and respect the safety of all persons in the area around the School.

### **Refuelling Arrangements:**

Service Crews are reminded of the general requirements regarding the appropriate clothing to be worn while refuelling cars and that all refuelling must be done, and all fuel stored, within the dedicated refuel zone provided adjacent to the School (refer map for location).

### **Safety and Site Induction Notes:**

1. Weather conditions can be changeable in the area and the adjoining Forest areas can experience a range of temperature in September. It is also possible that the area may experience rain. Ensure you have hats and sufficient water, food & protection from the sun;
2. Native wildlife is becoming very active at this time of year, especially snakes and large goannas. Watch where you walk, wear suitable enclosed shoes and clothing and be careful of wildlife when driving;
3. Toilets are located within the School grounds (refer attached map);
4. Food and drink is available from the catering area at the School. Food, coffee and refreshments are also available from the Bunya Nut Café in Blackbutt.
5. First aid will be provided at Rally HQ (refer attached map);
6. All emergency communication will be conducted via Rally HQ (refer attached map);
7. In the event of an emergency, the assembly area is the area between the School and the Rally regroup area (refer attached map);
8. The organisers do not encourage pets (dogs, etc) in the forests or near the School. However if it is necessary that pets are brought to the event they must be restrained by a collar and lead and kept under control at all times. Dog droppings are to be cleaned up and disposed of properly to ensure the hygiene of everyone using this site during and after the rally.
9. When using trolley jacks, please place jack stands under the car;
10. If you have young children, please keep them near you at all times as the area around the School will be a very busy place with a lot of traffic. If you take children to Spectator Points please take special care to ensure their safety at all times;
11. If you witness or are involved in an accident or incident at any of the event locations or public area, this must be reported to the Competitor Liaison Officer or the Event Secretary;

**Everyone at this event has a responsibility to ensure not only their own safety, but also contribute to the safety of others in their vicinity. Think globally, act locally.**

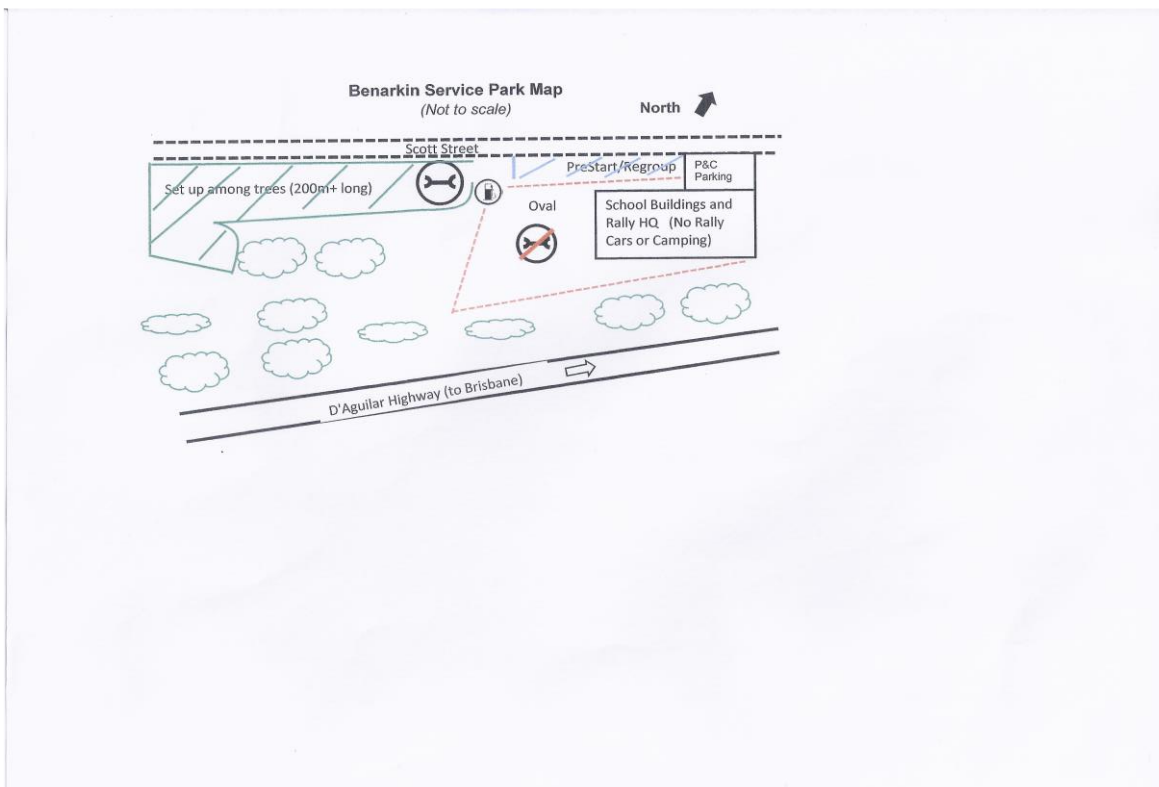
## SERVICE SCHEDULE

1. ALL SERVICING MUST BE CONDUCTED WITHIN THE DESIGNATED SERVICE PARK ADJACENT TO THE BENARKIN STATE SCHOOL.
2. PLEASE TAKE CARE AND PREVENT SPILLAGE OF OIL OR FUEL IN THE SERVICE PARK.
3. SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE ENTIRE SERVICE PARK IS 10 KPH.
