Dear Members,

As Rally sub-committee chairman and a steward for our club, I would like to bring a couple of things to your attention. As you probably realize our affiliation with C.A.M.S. naturally means that each of us must abide by the various codes and rules made by them. If you are a financial member of the B.S.C.C., this means you.

This applies to rallies, motorkhanas and even night runs. There are probably a few new members who may not be aware of such rules. If you intend to participate in any of these sports please obtain the relevant code and read it.

For example:- In a motorkhana, if you drive a "special" (open vehicle), it is compulsory for you to wear a crash helmet and goggles and have a roll cage fitted. Naturally it is for your own safety. For these events we obtain a permit from C.A.M.S., which includes insurance against public risk and so on. If a competitor is not abiding by the rules at the time of an accident, in which another person may be injured, this insurance cover can be null and void. In this case the organizer and his club are liable.

To avoid this possibility it is at the discretion of the clerk of the course to exclude any competitor. You are asked to please follow these rules and also present your membership card at any future closed club event.

"JOHN HUMPHREY MEMORIAL RALLY"

The weekend of the 7th and 8th August saw the running of the excellent John Humphries Memorial Rally. The Darling Downs Sporting Car Club has proved that it has come to age when it comes to organising rallies. This rally proved this quite convincingly. It was a very testing event on both cars and crew, due mainly to some very well organised long sections. These sections kept the drivers on their toes because of the very tight twisty conditions and kept the navigators alert, mainly due to many instructions very close together. It was these longer sections that really showed the best crews from the field.

The event started at Humphries Leyland in Toowoomba at 5.00 pm with 59 of the 60 entries starting. Lisle Newman was the only non starter because he did not have a navigator. The first division utilized public roads and forestry roads in Peechy and Yarraman forests. Two long sections, one 50 km and the other 86 km, left some crews temporarily lost due to very close instructions. Notable retirements early in the rally were Adrian Taylor/S. Smith in the Honda Civic with mechanical trouble a few kms into the 1st competitive section. Charlie O'Brien/R. Kelly, winner of the Townsville Rally, broke an axle early on in the event. The twisty conditions left numerous navigators very car sick, namely Peter Smith in the VW Golf, Greg Sked who navigates for Jim Reddiex. Scores at the division break showed Allan Hall/Bruce Mallett ahead on 48 from Peter Wickham/Dave Ambrose on 54, Hank and Simon Kabel on 58 and Ian Riedel/Peter Hines and Allan Ryan/Peter Whalley both only a couple of points behind.

The second division proved a very testing one in the local forests of Taromeo and Benarkin, with only three competitive sections. The 1st 27 km, the next 68 km and a very testing last section of 104 km to climax a very good rally. Section 4 proved to be the turning point in luck for many crews who missed a very well located VRC on a small road, which only about 20 meters before a major road, which most crews took by mistake. The most dis-appointed crew was Allan Hall and Bruce Mallett in their Mazda RX 2 relegated to second for missing the road with the VRC after looking like they were heading for their 2nd \$1000 in as many rallies. Allan Ryan/Peter Whalley who were in a very good position at the division break broke two axles 20 kms from the finish of the event. The end results showed Hank and Simon Kabel on 106 well clear from Allan Hall and Bruce Mallett on 125. Next was Neil Swaysland and John Hall in their Datsun on 136 and Trevor Ruddick/M. Kelly driving very consistently to a well deserved 4th outright and 1st recognized placing was Ian Riedel/Peter Hines followed on 146. These were the results for the classified crews. Tony Perrett/R. Pugh picked up the VRC and took the second recognized honours. The clubman awards were taken by Trevor Gynther/Iain Stewart followed by Ruth Tindal/John Blake and the Gibson brothers taking the 1st Novice award.

In conclusion, a well run event worthy of Qld Championship status and congratulations must go to Joe McCoach, the director, and the organizing committee for an excellent event.

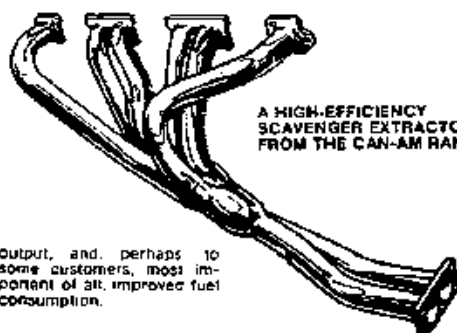

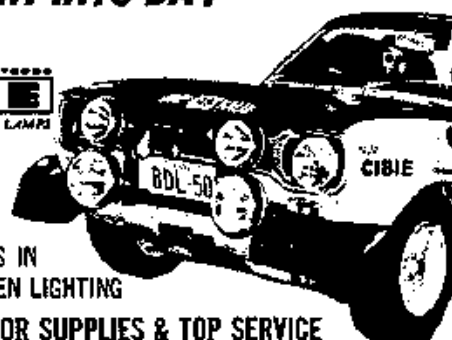

CONTROL OF CLUB PROPERTY

It appears that this is the first time that control of this nature has been exercised with club equipment. Please assist by looking after club property and reporting breakages or misuse. Remember that the property belongs to BSCC and is available for use by everyone within the club.

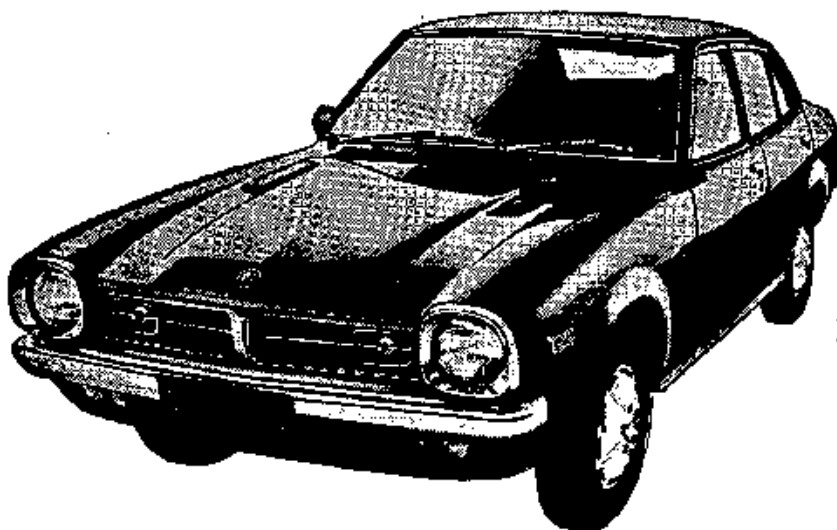

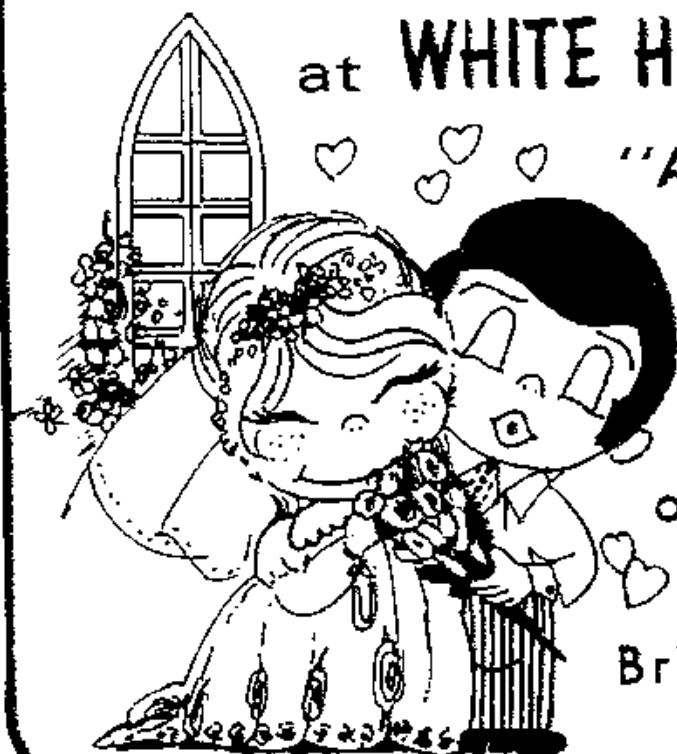
