Harry Bosboom and Chris Harbeck were on their first rally together although Chris has navigated on three other events. Their Cortina needed welding on the exhaust pipe at the Division break, abd then whilst turning round following a wrong slot they bent a tie-rod on a hidden stump. A 4km walk took them to the main road and a message was sent to the Service Crew. They loved the event and will certainly be back for more.

The all new Gerry Reynolds and Warren McKewen had an unfortunate second division. At the division break they were equal second but by the finish they'd dropped to seventh. The cause of their defise was the distributor cap falling off and the loss of the carbon, this was replaced with some of the lead from Warrens pencil and the silver from a cigarette packet. They were very pleased to finish with a four cylinder Torana.

Glen Somerville and Rod Hannifey were having their first outing in the ex-Fred Thompson Ford Escort RS2000.
