

Round 4 Queensland Rally Championship

Lance(r) says "Drop me off here"

While deep in the left hand seat I heard a heavenly choir singing "I Looked over Blackbutt and what did I see, coming for to carry me home.

A band of angels coming after me, coming for to carry me home".

Well since big myth Smiff burst on the scene after a good win on the Pacific Festival thrash, its all been downhill. I've decided that my big problem is DUST, it makes me sick and I don't like the thought of my one lung filling up with it. Purely as an aside but the stuff I was getting out of my nose (every man should have a hobby) after this event was BLACK.

However first things first. For myself I wasn't very interested in this event as it took place on the weekend that my secondhand bookshop became a two shop affair. (Today Sherwood, tomorrow the Empire Barracks Ballroom, Crumulla). So I set HardieTaylor the task of getting me to the finish at the earliest possible moment, and then taking me home - only a genuine SWINE could so comprehensibly stuff up such simple instructions.

The start procedure was kept as simple as possible as both Cap'n Whalley and Bruce Fullerton were there.. In my view the longest aviate at the knife-edge went I should think to Rod Browning and the new, mature, suddenly-I-can-get-into-the-Regal-Cinema-Graceville, Bruce Fullerton.

On the way to the next stage we followed another Lancer, but this one was made by Austin, and on the back window it had a sticker that said "My other car is a Rolls-Royce". Boy did we LAUGH, Ho-ho-ho, Ha-ha-ha, splutter - splutter. Mark said (and lord knows he's up on these things) it was Weigh Knee Poo or something. Don't forget that this months Grass-saying-that-means-nothing is "I'll be catching up with youse later", we could have had "G'day, whatdaya know ?" but then what would Glen Somerville have to say ?.

I cannot give too much inside info on this event owing to the type of person old Taylor attracts. He not only gives the entry list away on a regular basis, but Brian Stenzel takes the roadbook off me. Plus the fact that we arrive at the finish venue some hours after everybodys gone home, means that what I know about this event I read in the Redland Bay Boiler Makers and Canary Breeding Gazette. All I can say is that I had a totally Crapola run, and I don't think we had one cock-up free forestry stage. As I've said the dust stretched ones credulity. On the second stage, at an Auto-cross course in the Brisbane Valley, we were 9th car round and the ruts were a foot deep already, and all that matter that had been in the ruts was drifting across the valley. At the start of the first night forestry stage, a welcoming spot run by the Christian Motorsports Association, we collected to view the first cars off. Rod Brownings Gemini hasn't vast reserves of power driving through huge tyres, so it must be one of the 'minor' dust raisers. But in the 2 minutes from his departure until Ray Vandersee departed, the grit just hung in the air. So all honours to those ESCC members at the back of the field who did so well. George Kahler and Greg Weale had a fine run to win the Recognised class after a shorting battery cost them heaps of time on the second stage, Tim Bailey and John Blake were 2nd Clubmen in front of Norm and Coral Fritter, and old "Glazed expression" Tim Charalambous and Brian Catt were 2nd novice.

Our event ended on the penultimate stage at a Turn Right. Mark swung round on the hydraulic handbrake, unaware that the road had become a contour hugging track. Unable to see the road which lay further round than expected, he launched the Lancer between two likely trees only to slide 25 feet down a steep bank, grazing one big tree with my side (!) and stopping within inches of another big wood. For my part I couldn't tell what was happening. I took my eyes from the road to ensure that the Halda zeroed, and when I looked up we were dodging through the trees like a resistance fighter. Under the immense pressure of fear I stretched my seatbelts until I was under Marks left armpit - ordourous position but a healthy one. When the car came to a halt I said something totally Pommy-Grongo, like "I think the old bus has popped off the road - ha-ha !" I quickly scribbled a note and slapped it into the palm of Peter Garbett who was the next along with Alan Cutts, he certainly gets around, he did the Northern Districts with Peter Phillips.
