





# 1988 AUSTRALIAN RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP UNDER 2 LITRE CHAMPION

Class National Rally Champions Russell Reid and Chris Lane made a lengthy journey from Queensland to some of the best rally roads in Australia when they entered "Rally Australia", the biggest International Rally ever staged in Australia.

Sponsored by Castrol, Norse Volvo, Motorola Rentals and Toyo Tyres, Russell Reid Rallying's Volvo 360 GLT ran faultlessly to win their class in Group A and finish 19th outright. They were members of the official Queensland State Rally team which also won their category.

That the pisseure resout a so showing a comple of metersport videos and the first one was a Finneed production of the '87 Relly of New Zenfond.

Leading entries for this event included Stig Blomqvist in a Sierra 4x4 and Franz Wittman in a Delta but by far the most exciting to watch was Kenneth 'God' Ericsson in the works Colf Cli. This two-wheel drive car is made to do completely un-natural things in Ericeson's hands and his left foot braking and sheer speed is very well demonstrated in the footage shown in this video. Blomqvist had car trouble in that he lost the front drive but still managed to set some very fast times in only two-wheel drive. Australia was represented by David Officer's Starion and the purposeful Looking Corolla GT of Wayne Bell. Every time we see Officer he seems to be spinning out but he went on to finish in a fine 5th outright. Bell, on the other hand was driving very well and got up to Fourth outright when the Toyota's engine let go and he retired. We see some terrific footage of Possum Bourne driving a Subaru like no one else can and a guy called Ralph Meekings, who is a mamine, driving a Corolla 1300 in a suicidal way. Wittman won the event which must be the most pituresque on the WRC agenda. Definitely worth a look is this tape because the second haif is made up of Peugeot propaganda and includes some unbelievable commercials a la James Bond style, some Paris-Dakar stuff with Ari jumping a 205 about 100 metres and some sensational highlights of Peugeot's championship winning '86 season. The only thing I was a bit sus about was the speed of the Group B cars. I mean it looked like the film may have been sped up a teensy bit but of course this phenomenon could be a consequence of watching Group A then Group B.

## IN-CAR VARIOUS

This English production is just about all in-car on various events with differing conditions and drivers. We do about four stages of the 86 Circuit of Ireland with Billy Coleman in a works Porsche which includes some wet stuff and night stages. These events are of course pace-noted and it is interesting (impossible?) trying to decipher the instructions. There is also some stuff with the camera mounted on the front of the Porsche and the speed sensation is incredible travelling down the narrow country lames that characterise this event.

It is using this camera position that graphically demonstrates a 180 kmh spin by Saeed Al Hajri in his Porsche which loses its lights in the process. Saeed calmly does a U-turn and gets back into it but only after running over what

appears to be a spotlight in reasonable condition!

Other Lootage is of a Norway snow event in a Quattro which is interesting and some stuff with Russel Brookes on a wet event trying to keep the Manta in a straight line. We do a 180° with Russell and nudge a bank with his navigator telling him to "keep going". David Llewellin in another Quattro is also featured, this time on the 87 Welsh and the stand out of this footage was the wheel work required with the big 4WD Audi and the rather reticent co-driver.

This production also features music and is quite interesting but more of

a study tape than real entertainment.

Both these cassetes are available to hire from G.P. Cars, as are many others.




