### THE FESTIVAL STATE RALLY - SOUTH AUSTRALIA

### (AUSTRALIAN RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND 4)

Queensland once again did very well with the three Coote-prepared Mazdas in the first six placegetters. Murray third, us fifth, and Geoff Keys sixth. The other major placegetters were Greg Carr first (4 wins out of 4 events), Ed Ordinski second, and David Eadie fourth (he only beat us by about 12 seconds!). This should bring the Duckhams MAZDA fourth in the ARC pointscores and Queensland to the lead in the Interstate Challenge Shield, Ian Reddiex had a win in the 2 litre class (and a fairly good outright place). Other Queenslanders who competed were David Johansen and Russell Reid (both retired) and Rod Cross (third in the 1300 cc class).

For a state that can get roads closed in the centre of the City for the Grand Prix, closing roads in the suburbs for a Rally was only a relatively minor problem and we had four bitumen stages in the Adelaide Hills on the Sunday afternoon.

Most of the rest of the Rally was on closed Shire roads, with only two sections in the forestry. There are apparently some problems between the Forestry Department and motor sport in S.A. but the rest of the event made up for this.

The roads were very fast. Local knowledge was a big help but this year everybody was allowed to pace-mote the event to even things out. Lots of power and a high top gear were what was needed.

There were 44 entries of which 41 started, and 29 finished. Other notable retirements included Beli and Pietela in Mazdas, Tolcher and Mutton in Subarus, and Adrian Taylor's Sierra. There were some interesting local cars, including a very quick Falcon XW V8 automatic, a Valiant Charger, and a Peugeot 404 which were around when Jim Reddiex was a young bloke.

The standard of the instructions and all other paperwork was very good, but during the event there were obviously a few problems, as were held up at controls fairly regularly while waiting for sections to be zeroed etc. However, it was good to see an ARC round in SA after a few years of not having one, and the Director has indicated that he will again run the event in 1990.



### BRIDGESTONE INTERNATIONAL.

By the time this is printed the Bridgestone will be over so there is another opportunity for a good story. I will be navigating in the "You bute Ut" of Terry Rose, so its hang on to that Jesus Bar and lets get up it for me. I wouldn't swap it for any ...box rally car because Off Roading is the greatest sport on wheels.

On the weekend of 15/16 July competitors from all over the world took themselves and their equipment to New Zealand for the running of that country's round of the World Manufacturer's Championship.

Due to Rally Australia being granted World Driver's Championship status, that honour had been removed from the Kiwi round. Nonetheless, a high class field of 71 starters consisting of competitors from many overseas countries as well as the host country, commenced the 4 day event.

With factory teams from Mazda, Opel and Mitsubishi, it was bound to be a fight to the finish and that's what it was with a Japanese manufacturer taking off the winner's laurels. Crews from Japan, Italy, Gt. Britain, the Phillipines, Indonesia, Malaysia and Australia made up a portion of the competitors, and such names as Ingvar Carllson, Rod Millen, Malcolm Wilson, Ross Dunkerton and Colin McRae were present. Brisbane Sporting Car Club's international rovers for the Rally were George Kahlner and Tony Best whose Duckham's backed immaculate Mazda Familia was entered in Group N.

Amongst their competition were a Lancia Integrale, a Toyota Celica GT4, a number of Galant VR4's and a gaggle of other Mazda 323s.

After passing scrutineering with no problems, the team proceeded to complete the event with no mechanical problems, except for replacement brake pads.

The roads covered varied enormously and were likened to sections of Gympie (4GY), Western Australia and Alpine Territory.

Luckily George quickly assimilated to the most-Queensland-like roads and this was where the team performed best. Many of the roads were extremely fast and compare with the best Queensland Shire roads. The minority of the Rally covered Forestry made which were on the whole not nearly as smooth.

Other Queenslanders making their presence at the event included Jim Reddiex, who was servicing for the works Mitsubishis and Townsville's Geoff Keys who was spectating whilst keeping an eye on his Audi Guatrro, which is currently

leased to an N.Z. team. At the end of the event George and Tony had finished a very creditable 25th outright (after being seeded 41 and against very tough opposition) and 10th in Group N. They were the second Australian crew home after Dunko in 10th place outright (Mitsubishi Galant VR4) and naturally were the first Gueenslanders home.

George and Tony mamy run the car as Group N in Rally Australia but there is a chance that Group A is more likely to achieve results.

Would you please be advised the extra charge of \$11.00 per day only applies for vehicles being used for other purposes other than Relies or Touring Assembly events. (for example: - should a client require a permit to move their vehicle to have a Road Worthy.Inspection, the fee of \$11.00 plus \$1.00 per day would apply).

Would you please note these permits are normally used for unregistered vehicles and the cover usually applies for up to seven (7) days only.




