





Also congratulations to Ian Reddiex and Rodney Cross for winning their respective classes in the Australian Rally Championships.

I think I have gone on for too long but before I conclude I would like to thank all our sponsors, directors and organising committees for their efforts in making the Brisbane Sporting Car Club THE CLUB not forgetting that we ran two National Championships SEVEN DAYS apart.

Through the dogged persistence of Moss Lane, we might have chance of leasing some land and it is hoped that if this comes to pass, all members will put their efforts into making it into a successful venture.

I would also like to record my thanks to Esme Gibson, Administration Officer for her dedication throughout the year. Also I thank the members of the 1989 Board for their support.
