





CHANGES TO THE MOTOR SPORT CALENDAR

SHORT COURSE RALLY



GOLD COAST TOURIST TROPHY SUMMER RALLYSPRINT

A field of over 30 cars competed in the Gold Coast Tourist Trophy Summer Rallysprint on Sunday February 11, with strong interest being shown by local competitors. Event organiser Stuart Roberts said that considerable interest had been shown in the event - perhaps because it was the first tarmac rallysprint to be held in Queensland in many years. The rallysprint was held on a 5km stretch of closed, sealed public road on the Gold Coast. Based at Pimpama State School, Hotham Creek Road, Pimpama, the Gold Coast Tourist Trophy Summer Rallysprint was run by the organisers of the Gold Coast Tourist Trophy tarmac special stage rally, a five day event to be held from August 8-12.

Entries in the rallysprint included John Spencer, winner of Classic Adelaide 2000, Beric Lynton, who has recently returned from competing at Nurburgring and was driving a BMW, and Ultima Cars, which entered one of its new supercars. Denis Baker competed in one of the Round Australia Holden Commodores, as well as entries from the owners of several Datsun Zs, Porsches, BMWs, Subarus and Westfields (with the unfortunate demise of the Owen/Kerridge Westfield).




