COMING EVENTS IN DETAIL

NIGHT RUN WEDNESDAY 1st NOVEMBER

FILM NIGHTS MONDAY, TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, 6th, 7th, 8th NOV.

B.S.C.C. will conduct three film nights at the Boomerang Theatre, Ipswich Road, Annerley on 6th, 7th and 8th November.

There will be a 'first release' of films not previously shown in Queensland. These films will cover :-

- Motor Racing in America and Australia
- Car Trials and Rallies
- Feature Films

Members are invited to bring their families and friends to see these new films. Your attendance will help swell Club funds.

NIGHT RUN WEDNESDAY, 8th NOVEMBER

One of our newer members, Tony Reason, will be organising this run with the help of Brian Mills. They haven't given any clues, but it is expected it will be on the south side.

The usual night run equipment of torch, pencil and paper is all that will be required.

INTER-CLUB TRIAL SATURDAY, SUNDAY 11th & 12th NOVEMBER

I.W.M.A.C. is conducting the Inter-Club Trial, which will be Queensland Championship Event Number Seven.

When Supplementary Regulations are available from the organisers, copies will be available from the Secretary or at the Club rooms. No details on the type of event are known as yet.

In the Inter-Club Trial, three crews from one Club can, if they wish, nominate as a team, thus making it an inter-club teams, as well as individual crew, event.

This trial has been a regular event on the trials calendar for a number of years, and if the standard is similar to Ipswich's Dusk to Dawn Rally earlier this year, it should be a very good event.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING WEDNESDAY, 15TH NOVEMBER

OPEN GYMKHANASUNDAY, 19th NOVEMBER

C.V.W.C.C. will conduct the fourth and final Open Gymkhana on the 19th November at their Mt. Petrie grounds.

To reach the grounds, proceed past Mt. Gravatt Motors and take the first road on the left (Broadwater Rd.). Follow this for a mile or so past the Mt. Petrie School on your left. The events conducted in heats will be :-

The timed events will be :-

- Autocross
- Serpentine

Two lanes only will be used in each event, each driver attempting each event twice, i.e. once in each lane.
