# **SERVICE CREW INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Notes to Service Crews**

As a sport, we gain Permits from Motorsport Australia, Qld Police Service, HQ Plantations and the Gympie Regional Council and our actions are highly visible to the public and these organisations. Therefore we request that all Service Crews drive in a courteous and professional manner that will be a credit to our sport.

Note that due to COVID19 restrictions and the Motorsport Australia Return to Race Strategy there will be no spectating at this event. Please remember to maintain social distancing within the Service Park and maintain a high standard of hand hygiene. Do not share tools or equipment with other teams.

If your competing crew is unable to continue during the event, every reasonable effort will be made to inform you of their location and what action needs to be safely taken, as is the case in all other rallies

## **How to get to Imbil Showgrounds**

Imbil is a small township in the Mary Valley Hinterland south west of Gympie and north of Kenilworth. It is accessible from the Bruce Highway via good quality bitumen roads.

### **Suggested route for travel from Brisbane using Bruce Highway**

Follow the Bruce Highway from its junction with the Gateway Motorway near the South Pine River past the Redcliffe, Morayfield, Caboolture and Kilcoy turnoffs and continue past Nambour and Kenilworth turnoffs towards Gympie. At Exit 244 (Borumba Dam/Imbil) turn left off the Highway and follow signs to Imbil. In Imbil, turn left into Edward Street and follow past the Hall and the Mary Valley College until you see the signage for the Rally and Service Park.

The Bruce Highway between Brisbane and the Imbil turn-off (Exit 244) and the connecting road to Imbil are in good condition. There are still roadworks in the vicinity of the Landsborough/Caloundra turn-off.

Allow at least 2 hours to travel from the northern suburbs of Brisbane to Imbil.

Please set up in the designated Service Area. To enable all cars to be serviced, please limit the area you use. Trailers can be parked within your Service Area. All fuel is to be placed in the designated Refuel Zone before the Rally Cars depart on Saturday morning.

### **Speed Limits within and around Imbil and Region**

The Imbil and Kandanga communities are aware of the Rally happening around their townships. Please respect their hospitality and goodwill by driving sensibly and always comply with local speed limits and those set out in the Service Instructions. The area around Imbil Showgrounds will be active with rally traffic including officials, competing crews, service vehicles and local residents. Please be attentive and respect the safety of all persons.

### **Refuelling Arrangements:**

Service Crews are reminded of the general requirements regarding appropriate clothing to be worn while refuelling cars. All fuel is to be stored in dedicated Service Park Refuel Zone. All refuelling must be done in either the Remote Refuel Zones or the Service Park Refuel Zone. Fuel taken to a Remote Refuel Zone must be returned to the Service Park Refuel Zone after use (refer map for locations).

### **Safety and Site Induction Notes:**

1. Weather conditions can be changeable in the area during September and the area may experience rain. Ensure you have hats and sufficient water, food & protection from the sun;
2. Wildlife is active in September especially snakes which are coming out of hibernation. Livestock may also be present along unfenced roads. Watch where you walk, wear suitable enclosed shoes and clothing and be careful of wildlife when driving;
3. Toilets are located within the Imbil Showgrounds (refer attached map);
4. Food, coffee and refreshments are available from the servery in the Service Park. There is a grocery store, Bakery and cafes in the main street of Imbil.
5. First aid will be provided within the Service Park (refer attached map);
6. In the event of an emergency, the assembly area is the area between the Regroup and the ring (refer attached map);
7. The organisers do not encourage pets (dogs, etc) in the Service Park. However if it is necessary that pets are brought to the event they must be restrained by a collar and lead and kept under control at all times. Dog droppings are to be cleaned up and disposed of properly to ensure the hygiene of everyone using these sites.
8. When using trolley jacks, please place jack stands under the car;
9. If you have young children, please keep them near you at all times as the area around the Service Park and Regroup will be a very busy place with a lot of traffic;
10. If you witness or are involved in an accident or incident at any of the event locations or public area, this must be reported to the Competitor Relations Officer or the Event Secretary

**Everyone at this event has a responsibility to ensure not only their own safety, but also contribute to the safety of others in their vicinity. Think globally, act locally.**

### IMPORTANT NOTES:

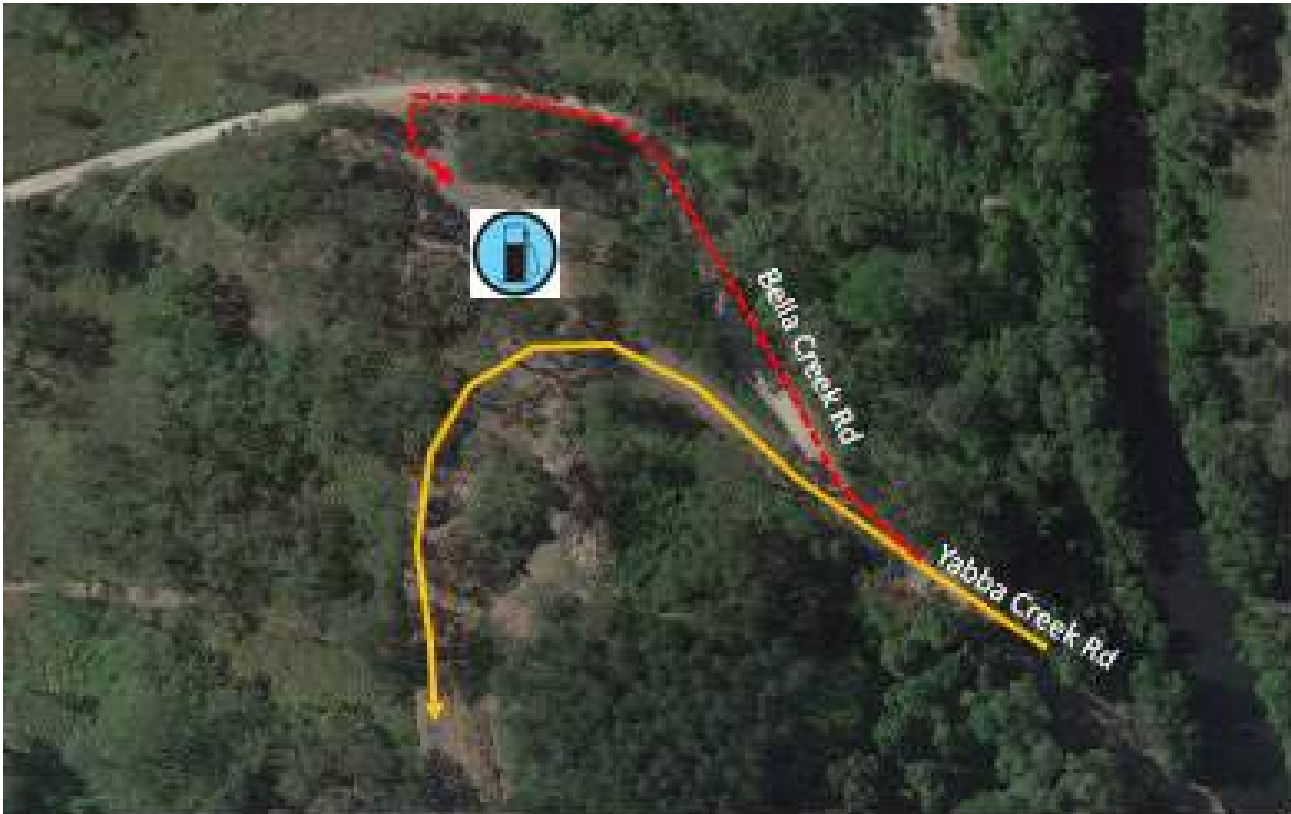
1. ALL SERVICING MUST BE CONDUCTED WITHIN THE DESIGNATED SERVICE PARK IN THE IMBIL SHOWGROUNDS.
2. PLEASE USE GROUNDSHEETS TO PREVENT SPILLAGE OF OIL OR FUEL ON THE GRASS SURFACE OF THE SERVICE PARK.
3. SPEED LIMIT WITHIN THE ENTIRE SERVICE PARK IS 10 KPH.

B	Imbil Service Park	1540 hrs	20 mins	Refuel (RZ 2) <b>after</b> Service B in the designated refuel zone.

## **\*Instructions to and from Remote Refuel (optional) at Borumba**

Zero tripmeter at exit from Service Park. TR from Edward Street into Diggings Road and follow to the main street of Imbil (Yabba Creek Road). Turn left into Yabba Creek Road and follow over the disused railway line and continue past the Police Station out of Imbil. Observe changes to Speed limits.

About 5.8 kms from the disused railway line, go SO past Derrier Road (watch for rally traffic on left). Continue on the main road for another 3.5 kms, then TR with care off the bitumen onto gravel road widening before a left hand bend. Proceed to the remote refuel zone as indicated by an official and park safely. Refuel your rally car and then return to Imbil Service Park using the reverse of this route.



**Please use Edward Street entry from Yabba Creek Road as you cannot enter the Service Park from Diggings Road (One Way traffic).**
