SERVICE CREW INSTRUCTIONS

Notes to Service Crews

As a sport, we gain Permits from Motorsport Australia, Qld Police Service, HQPlantations, the Gympie and Somerset Regional Councils and our actions are highly visible to the public and these organisations. Therefore, we request that all Service Crews drive in a courteous and professional manner that will be a credit to our sport.

Please remember to maintain social distancing within the Service Park and maintain a high standard of hand hygiene. Do not share tools or equipment with other teams.

If your competing crew is unable to continue during the event, every reasonable effort will be made to inform you of their location and what action needs to be safely taken, as is the case in all other rallies

Site and Induction Notes

1. Weather conditions can be changeable in the area during March and the area may experience rain. Ensure you have hats and sufficient water, food & protection from the sun;
2. Livestock may also be present along unfenced roads. Watch where you walk, wear suitable enclosed shoes and clothing and be careful of wildlife when driving;
3. Toilets are located within the Manumbar Campdraft Grounds (refer attached map);
4. Food, coffee and refreshments are available from the servery in the Manumbar Campdraft Grounds CASH ONLY for food and drinks.
5. First aid will be provided within the Service Park (refer attached map);
6. In the event of an emergency, the assembly area is the area between the Regroup and the ring (refer attached map);
7. The organisers do not encourage pets (dogs, etc) in the Service Park, however if it is necessary that pets are brought to the event they must be restrained by a collar and lead and kept under control at all times. Dog droppings are to be cleaned up and disposed of properly to ensure the hygiene of everyone using these sites.
8. When using trolley jacks, please place jack stands under the car;
9. If you have young children, please keep them near you at all times as the area around the Service Park and Regroup will be a very busy place with a lot of traffic;
10. If you witness or are involved in an accident or incident at any of the event locations or public area, this must be reported to the Competitor Relations Officer or the Event Secretary

Everyone at this event has a responsibility to ensure not only their own safety, but also contribute to the safety of others in their vicinity. Think globally, act locally.



Where is Manumbar?

Manumbar is approximately 90kms from Kilcoy travelling North on the Kilcoy/Murgon Road.

From Brisbane take the Bruce Highway North then take the D'Aguiar Highway (Kilcoy) exit off the highway.

In Kilcoy you can turn right and proceed up the Jimna range (80kph) and just past Jimna it's a gravel road for approximately 42kms to Manumbar. The road from Jimna to Manumbar has recently been graded and is in good condition for most of the journey. Small sections close to Gallangowan are still slightly rough.

Where is the Service Park & HQ?

Manumbar: Manumbar Campdraft Association Grounds which is on the Manumbar Rd at Manumbar – approx 500 mts east of the Intersection of Manumbar Rd and Kilcoy-Murgon Road

What facilities are at Manumbar?

Please note:

There is **no fuel** at Manumbar.

There is camping at the Campdraft grounds plus showers/toilets and catering by the Campdraft Association from Friday night through to Sunday morning camping must be booked with the event secretary.

Each competitor will be allocated a numbered service bay prior to the event. Size is approx 15 x 8 mtrs, multiple bays may be available upon request.

Each bay should consist of driver/co-driver and service team members

Competitors and service crews are reminded to avoid sharing of equipment.

Competitors are asked to refuel their vehicles at the end of service to allow their vehicles to cool to try to prevent splash fires.

You are reminded that your campsite and service bay are in two distinct areas

Service Locations and times for the event

Manumbar - 1 service with time allowed 20 minutes: first car due approx. 1230 hrs

Remote Refuel Location:

There is one remote refuel location between SS2 and SS3 (Camp 1) and later between SS6 and SS7 (Camp 2). This is located on Boundary Road Elginvale and the first car is due at approx. 1115hrs and again later at 1440hrs.

From Manumbar Campdraft Ground TL along Manumbar Road in 500mtrs SO at XR then travel 9.5kms. TL at Porter Road and travel 3.5kms. Prior to the grid turn around park and carry your fuel to the designated refuel area, an official will be in place to guide you. You should allow approx. 5 minutes to refuel.

Please note: NO SERVICING is allowed at this location and it will be policed.
