Hi Everyone.

Beyond these events, the Globe Roamer Imbil Forest Rally is due to run on 4th of September and Clerk of Course, Mal Bartolo, reports all being in place to date and a new combination of roads in daylight and night promises to be as new a test as Imbil can manage.

The club is still working away at an Off Road event later in the year but there are challenges. Anyone who can help with that event, please come forward. Barry Neuendorff has done a splendid job in the past setting up events and being Clerk of Course as has Rod Sams and Craig Porter, but there are limits to what these three great

stalwarts of the club can achieve. Anything you can do to help this event will be greatly appreciated. Barry has years of Off Roading experience behind him and his last event saw him Clerk of Course at the 2021 Finke Desert Race so he is a great help to the helper.



The radio trailer has arrived and Craig Porter, Simon Knowles and I set to dismantling the rig to be readied for much needed maintenance. It is shaping up to be a real asset as we will have ample space to store the radios in transit, secure mounting and fully weather proofed radio repeater, batteries and voltage regulator from the rooftop mounted solar panels. There is a sturdy 12 metre mast too. Work is underway and the hope is it will be ready for Manumbar. In it will be our newly acquired repeater. We'll name it Howard the Repeater in honour of the generous donation by Tony and Belinda Howard.

We have a new Vice-President, V-P, Veep, Deputy Chair - all round great supporter of the BSCC - Tony Kabel.

Thanks Tony for stepping into the role.

Tony has been around the club for many years and lately has been working behind the scenes in course checking and event set-up. (And planking!!??)





With many new club members joining the ranks it would be great to hear your story and what motorsport your involved in.

BSCC Working Bee



As many will know, the Roo Systems Australia Manumbar Rally has been postponed several times now due to flood and fire. The event has been rescheduled to August 7th and hopes are high we will have a great event in the prime rally season in Queensland.

BSCC has had a heavy schedule in the last few months so I am grateful that many of the same people have rolled over their roles from other BSCC events. It is also pleasing that we have new blood stepping in to help as well. Soon we will be putting out the call for volunteers, so please mark the date and help out as you can.

In terms of the event itself, we will be using most all the good work done by Craig Porter and his team to put the previous events together. The event will be a compact, all daylight blind event run over four stages used twice. For a distance over just over 120km. It will be based out of the Manumbar Campdraft Ground and camping is on offer. The event will use Rallysafe, so make your preparations accordingly.

In terms of schedule. The organising team has just stepped into the role and good progress is being made on completing all the necessary permits and approvals. 
