SERVICE CREW INSTRUCTIONS

Notes to Service Crews

As a sport, we gain Permits from Motorsport Australia, Qld Police Service, HQ Plantations, Somerset Regional Councils and our actions are highly visible to the public and these organisations. Therefore, we request that all Service Crews drive in a courteous and professional manner that will be a credit to our sport.

Please remember to maintain social distancing within all areas of the event and maintain a high standard of hand hygiene. Do not share tools or equipment with other teams.

If your competing crew is unable to continue during the event, every reasonable effort will be made to inform you of their location and what action needs to be safely taken, as is the case in all other rallies

Site and Induction Notes

1. Weather conditions in Jimna in February can be changeable. Ensure you have hats and sufficient water, food & protection from the sun and rain.
2. Wildlife including snakes are on the move in February. Be careful walking in grassed or wooded areas, wear suitable enclosed shoes and clothing and be careful of wildlife when driving.
3. The stages are in forestry areas so be aware of logging operations and large heavily laden logging trucks and drive responsibly.
4. Rally service instructions include speed limits. **These are to be adhered to at all times.**
5. Roads in the Jimna area will be used by competing vehicles, service vehicles, officials, spectators and public traffic. Therefore, drivers must be attentive of vehicles unexpectedly turning or stopping and possible dusty conditions. Please drive safely at all times and comply with speed limits.
6. Toilets are located at the Jimna Base Camp.
7. First aid is available at the Jimna Base Camp.
8. All Emergency communication must be conducted via Rally HQ.
9. Motorsport Australia OH&S policies are in force within the Rally HQ, Service Park, Spectator points and around all Special Stages.
10. No alcohol is to be consumed by Officials, Competitors or their Service Crews prior to the event finishing.
11. The organisers do not encourage pets (dogs, etc.) in the Service Park or at Spectator points. If it is necessary that pets be brought to the event they must be restrained by a collar and lead and kept under control at all times.
12. If you visit the Service Park with young children, keep them near you at all times as the Service Park in the Jimna Base Camp will be very busy with a lot of traffic. If you take children to Spectator Points, please take special care to ensure their safety at all times. In particular, do not attempt to cross or walk on cane train or main railway tracks at any time.
13. Fire extinguishers must be ready for use when refuelling and refuelling can only occur in the designated area. All bulk fuel must be stored in the designated area. No smoking is permitted in or around any vehicle being refuelled.
14. When using trolley jacks, have jack stands under the car.
15. If you witness or are involved in an accident or incident at any of the event locations or public area, you must report it to the Competitor Relations Officer or the Event Secretary.

Everyone at this event has a responsibility to ensure not only their own safety, but also contribute to the safety of others in their vicinity. Think globally, act locally.

How to Get to Jimna.

From Brisbane to Jimna	Note: These instructions commence at the 100kph sign after the intersection of the Bald Hills Road and the M3 at Bald Hills. The distances have been set using a Terra Trip rally computer.
0.00	Straight on and follow M3 and M1 towards the Sunshine Coast
28.80	Take the <u>Kilcoy exit</u> from Bruce Highway and follow the <u>Kilcoy signs (152B)</u>
42.93	SO, through Wamuran
53.00	SO, through D'Aguilar to Woodford (BP service station on left)
56.14	SO, through Woodford
60.45	SO, at the Kilcoy/Beerwah intersection and follow to Kilcoy
78.38	SO, at Mt Kilcoy intersection and follow into Kilcoy
	NOTE: Kilcoy is last chance for fuel and food. If you need fuel or food, TL in centre of Kilcoy (stop tripmeter) and follow to BP garage (Diesel, RON98 etc.) Return to MR and TL @ TJ and restart tripmeter
81.50	TR at Clock tower and follow Kennedy Street
83.94	KL to Jimna (Kilcoy-Murgon Rd)
	Start board for 0 – 5km Terra Trip accuracy distance check
120.02	SO (do not KR to Jimna)
120.55	TR into Forest Station (Forest Office sign) Cross grid and follow bitumen road down past HQ Plantations office towards Jimna Sports Club. TR @ TJ and follow bunted road into service park on Old Jimna School Oval below Sports Club. (See map) max speed 40kph
	Please Park in designated areas (see map) without taking up too much space. We have to fit in all crews and officials.

Speed Limits within and around Jimna

The Jimna community is aware the Rally is happening around their township. Please respect their hospitality and goodwill by driving sensibly and always complying with local speed limits and those set out in the Service Instructions.

The area around Jimna Base Camp will be active with rally traffic including officials, competing crews, service vehicles, spectator vehicles and local residents. In addition, young children could also be running, walking and playing in the area. Please be attentive and respect the safety of all persons in the area around Jimna Base Camp.

Refuelling Arrangements:

Service Crews are reminded of the general requirements regarding the appropriate clothing to be worn while refuelling.

Where possible please remove trailers from the service park after unloading and park them in the trailer parking as shown on map.
