1. Introduction and Welcome to Lakes Hyundai Imbil Forest Rally

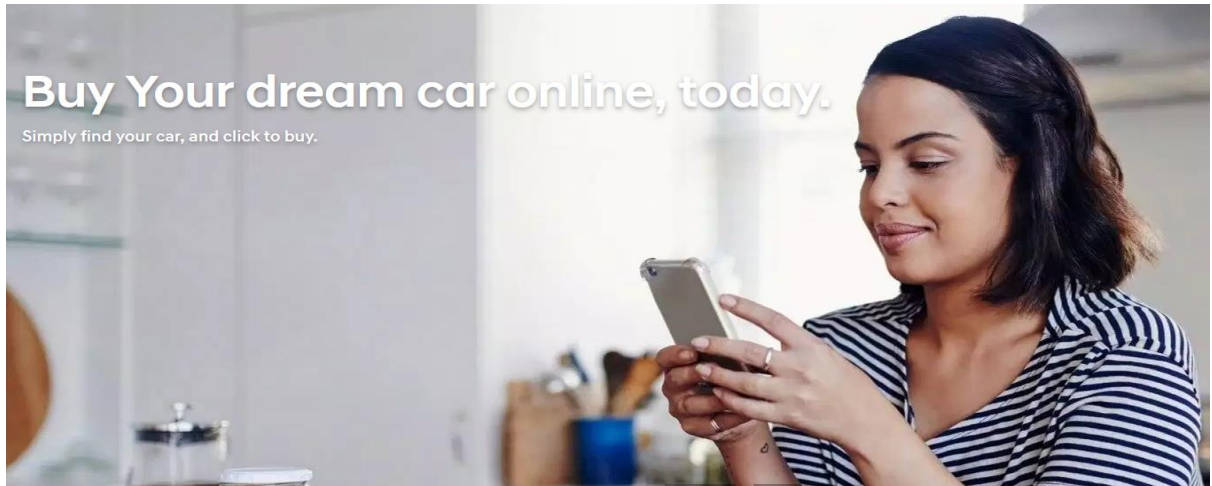

4. Event Overview

The event is a State Championship status Special Stage Rally conducted over closed forestry roads in the Imbil & Amamoor State Forest. It is planned to run 8 special stages for a total competitive distance of approximately 116kms. All stages are on gravel road surfaces. There is approximately 130kms of liaison stages on both bitumen and gravel surfaces.

It is planned that Competitors in the Queensland Rally Championship will compete over the full distance of the event. Competitors in the Novice series must complete stage 1 – 4 but can select the option to compete over the full event with no additional benefit to points. Heat 1 will be for stages 1 – 4 and Heat 2 for stages 5 - 8.

5. Getting to Imbil.

Imbil is a small township in the Mary Valley Hinterland south west of Gympie and north of Kenilworth. It is accessible from the Bruce Highway via good quality bitumen roads.

Suggested route for travel from Brisbane using Bruce Highway

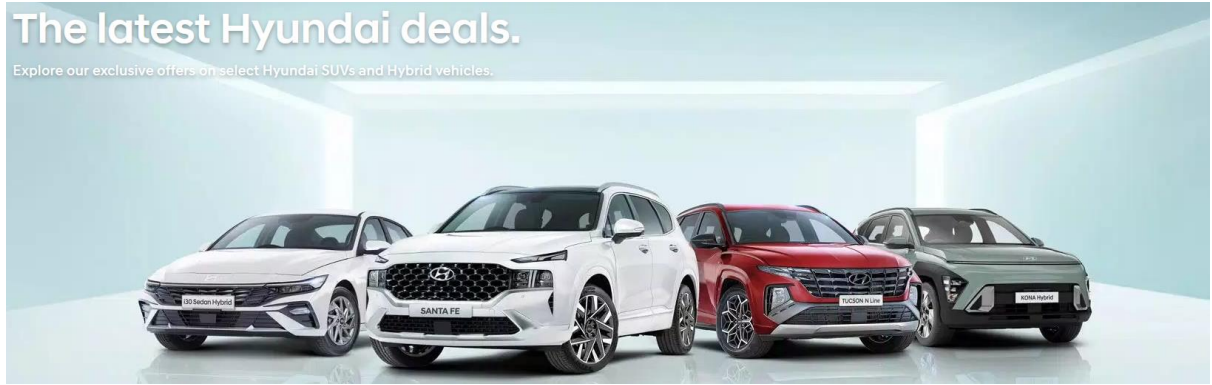
Follow the Bruce Highway from its junction with the Gateway Motorway near the South Pine River past the Redcliffe, Morayfield, Caboolture and Kilcoy turnoffs and continue past Nambour and Kenilworth turnoffs towards Gympie. At Exit 244 (Borumba Dam/Imbil) turn left off the Highway and follow signs to Imbil.

Alternatively, continue north to EXIT 253 then left past the CALTEX Traverston Service Centre and continue along the Mary Valley Connection Road to the Mary Valley Road then turn left and follow signage to Imbil.

In Imbil, travel through Imbil west along Yabba Creek Road, after crossing the railway line, travel west another 7k then turn left into Derrier road then 650m to the third stone gateway on your right; you will see the signage for the Rally and Service Park.

The Bruce Highway between Brisbane and the Imbil turn-off (Exit 244) and the connecting road to Imbil are in good condition.

Allow at least 2 hours to travel from the northern suburbs of Brisbane to Imbil.



6. Service Park and Refuelling

6.1 Service Park

The Service Park will be located in the grounds of the Stirling Crossing Equestrian Complex west of Imbil. The surface is level hard packed grass. No on-site power is available, A detailed map with the layout of the Service Park and the Service Itinerary will be in the Event Service Crew Instructions which will be available on the BSCC website prior to the event and will be provided to competitors at documentation.

6.2 Refuelling

Crews should bring sufficient unleaded fuel for their rally car and petrol support vehicles. Please note that there is now 98 RON pump fuel in Liberty Imbil. The other BP 98 RON fuel is available from the Forest Glen Service Station (off Bruce Highway heading north) or from BP Service Stations in Gympie. Alternatively, there is 98 RON available at the new CALTEX Traverston Service centre north of EXIT 244 at EXIT 253.

There is unleaded 91 RON & 95 RON petrol and Diesel fuel available in Imbil at the new Liberty Service Station as well as the Imbil Family Grocer.

It is planned that the maximum distance between refuels will be 106 kilometres of which 43 kilometres will be special stage.

It is planned to have allow refuelling at the Service Park between stages 4&5 and 7&8 and details will be given in the Supplementary Regulations. In Heat 1 there will be a Remote Refuel Zone between SS3 & SS4. Details will be published in a bulletin.

A Refuel Zone will be set up within the Service Park.

If a rally car is using an unleaded fuel other than 98 RON or E85, that crew will need to make own arrangements for the transport of fuel to the rally and dispensing Refuel Zones.
