This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity & Legal and Risk Management Policies. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. <b>Entry Fee</b>	<p><b>Adults: \$50.00</b>  <b>Adults: \$60.00</b> (includes BSCC day membership if not a member of any Motorsport Australia affiliated Club)  <b>Junior: \$40.00</b> (12 year to Under 18 years)</p> <p><b><i>Payment is to be made when submitting entry. No entries on the day</i></b></p>
<b>Entry Limitations</b>	Entries will be limited to <b>40</b> drivers. Although there will <b>NO</b> limit to spectators or the number of campers. <b>Expressions of interest recommended for catering purposes.</b> A maximum of <b>two</b> drivers can be entered in one vehicle.
<b>Drivers Eligibility</b>	<p>Either a Current Motorsport Australia competition <b>Speed/Speed Junior licence</b> (or higher)</p> <p><b>Junior drivers from 12 years of age</b> are welcome with their parent or guardian consent and they must be in attendance of the event</p> <p>Be a current financial Motorsport Australia affiliated <b>Club Member</b>.</p> <p>For those who wish to Come &amp; Try a One Time Introductory Licence is available from this link at a cost of \$30.00.</p> <p><a href="#">24motorsport-australia_introductory-licence-application.pdf</a></p>

<b>Safety Requirements</b>	<p>A fire extinguisher <b>MUST</b> be fitted as per standard requirements of the Motorsport Australia Manual Schedule H. The minimum requirement is 900g capacity AS 1841, and be fully charged,</p> <p>Particular heed should be taken to battery security, seat security, roadworthy condition of suspension, seat belts / safety harness and tyres as per the NCR.</p> <p>All vehicles must be fitted with an effective exhaust silencer system at all times. The maximum noise emission permissible is 95db(A)</p> <p>No loose items are to be stored inside the cabin or in the boot  Windows must be fully in the up position when competing</p>
<b>Tyres</b>	<p>All cars must only run road orientated tyres</p> <p><b>**No Rally, All-Terrain, Mud, Lug tyres or Hand-cut tyres.</b></p>

<b>Scrutiny</b>	Vehicle safety audits will be conducted on the day before commencement of the Event. Technical Appendix Scheule A and Group 4K
<b>Apparel</b>	<p>Ankle to wrist non- synthetic/non-flammable clothing must be worn (including closed in non-synthetic shoes) at all times when competing.</p> <p>Eye protection (not sunglasses) is required for all non-production or open vehicles.</p> <p>Helmet at a minimum must bear Australia Code AS1608 or subsequent Codes.</p> <p>Apparel, including helmets, must comply with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.</p>
<b>Passenger</b>	<p>A second person is allowed in the competing vehicles for <u>training and instruction purposes</u> <b>ONLY</b>. Instructors will need a Motorsport Australia Official's Coach licence.</p> <p>No Junior passenger is allowed in with a Junior Driver.</p> <p>Apparel and helmet requirements are the same as a competitor for passengers</p> <p>Passenger Ride Entry Forms are to be completed to obtain wrist band to be able to ride in competing vehicle.</p>
<b>Speed Limits</b>	<p>Access track max speed is 10 km/h.</p> <p>Service Park &amp; Spectator areas max 10 km/hr.</p>
<b>Health &amp; Safety</b>	<p>All competitors have a duty of care to their pit crew, other competitors and the general public to identify and take measures to eliminate or control hazardous situations or procedures during the Event. All persons must observe and obey safety-related directions from the Clerk of Course or other senior official.</p> <p>Jack stands must support any vehicle raised off the ground, or a second device as well as the jack, while working under the vehicle. No Smoking within the Competition Area or near Spectators.</p> <p>Refueling is prohibited in the Pit Area, Competition Area and Spectator Area. It is recommended that competing Vehicles are already fueled prior to attending the Event. If you have transported fuel it must remain in the transport vehicle unless being decanted within an area location approved by the Clerk of Course. A Fire Extinguisher must be out and ready for use.</p>
<b>Abandonment or Termination of the Event</b>	The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
<b>Refusal to Start</b>	Entries may be refused to start at the discursions of the Clerk of Course
<b>Spectators</b>	Spectators are welcome, Spectators are <b>NOT</b> permitted in the competition area and must follow the direction of Event Officials
<b>Media</b>	<p>By entering and or officiating at this event drivers and officials agree to have their photographs appear on the BSCC social media pages and press releases These photos will be for sale by the Motorsport Australia registered photographers attending the event.</p> <p>Any photographer attending the event must present themselves to the Clerk of Course and Sign On</p>

<b>Integrity</b>	<p>Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.</p> <p>Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at <a href="http://www.motorsport.org.au">www.motorsport.org.au</a>.</p> <p>Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, an Australian drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.</p> <p>Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.</p>
<b>Demonstration Runs</b>	<p>May be conducted by acknowledged Motorsport Australia licensed competitors. This Event may include Demonstrations in accordance with the NCR.</p>

### Appendix A - Negotiating the tests

Arrows, numbers, witches’ hats, bollards, and tape will be used to designate the ‘test’.

ALWAYS drive around the outside of a directional arrow indicating a turn.

Stop in the Finish Garage for a couple of seconds before moving off.
